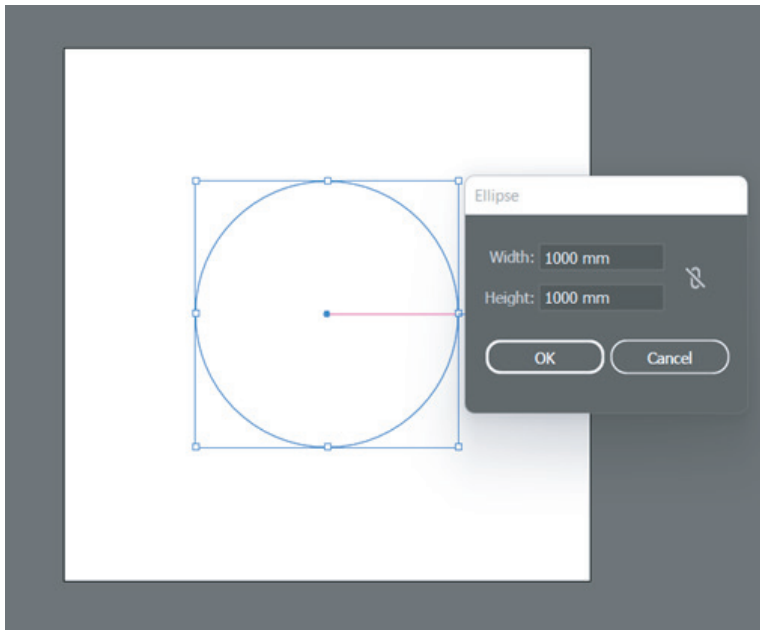
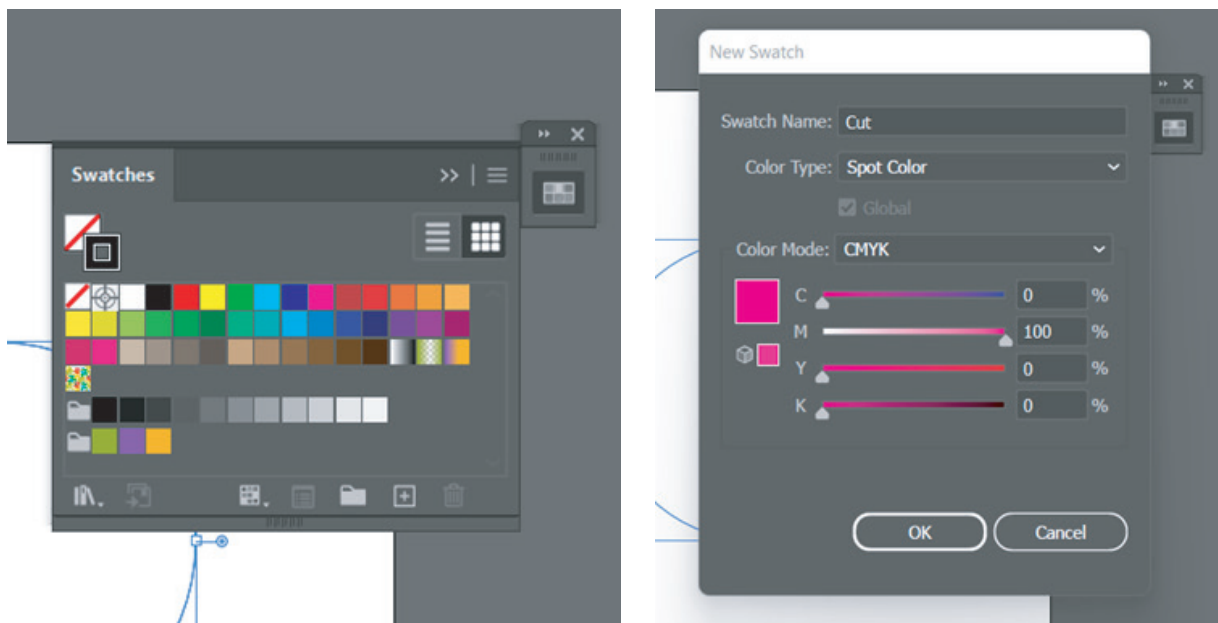




To make a cut-out it is necessary to be made as a vector line, a software as Adobe Illustrator is suitable. Photo editing programs such as Adobe Photoshop are not qualified to make a cut-out. Cutting lines shaped rectangular or square will be generated automatically based on the by you specified sizes.



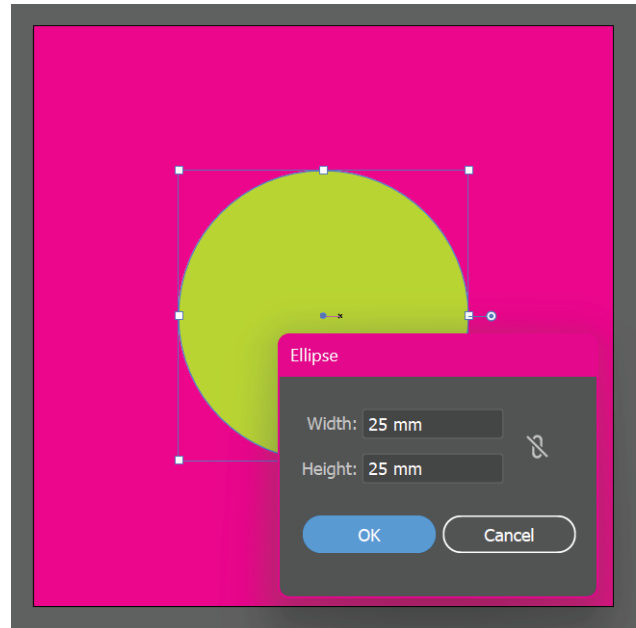
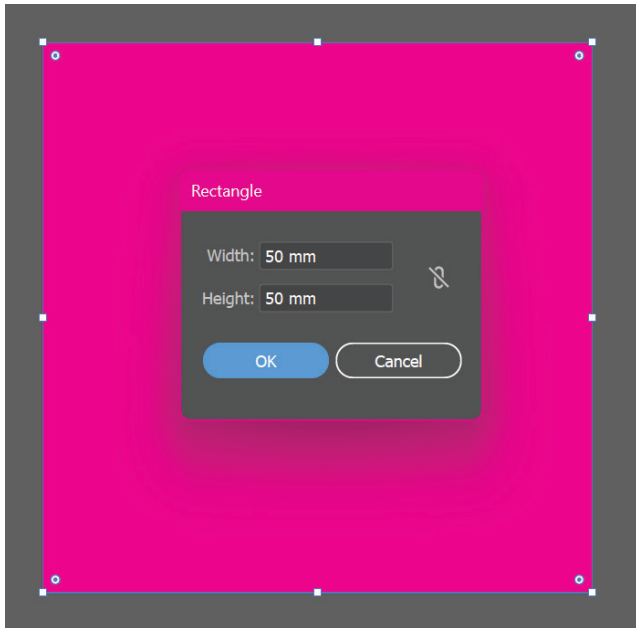
To start, make a closing line in the desired shape.



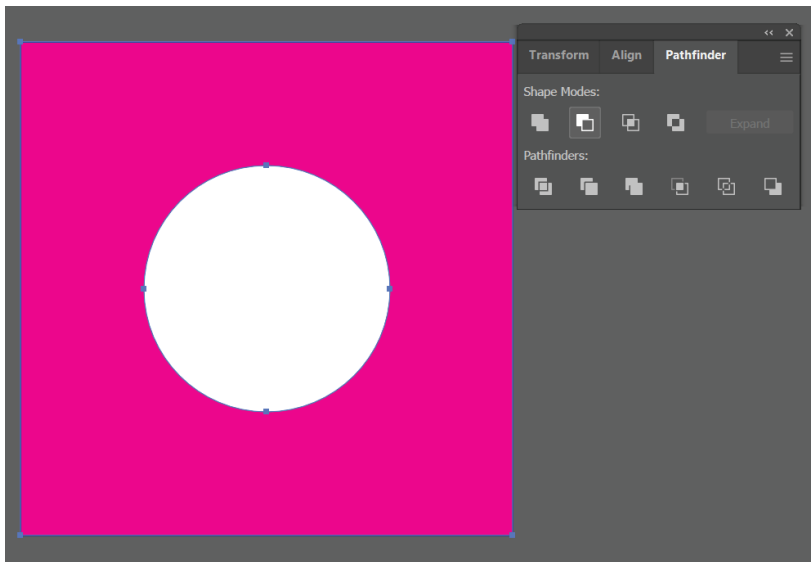
Next you open the Swatches window. Inhere you turn the line into a spot colour. Create a new swatch. Name the swatch Cut, turn it into a spot colour as 100% Magenta. Click OK to apply. The line will not be printed.



When making a cut contour with cutout, you start with an object with fill color. Start with the shape of the total width and height, this is the base. Then you make another object, this is the shape of the cutout. Place this exactly where the cutout should be, relative to the other shape. Give it a distinct color.



Select both objects and open the Pathfinder window. Use the Minus Front mode. The most upper object will be extracted from the object underneath. This makes it a compound path.



Next you open the Swatches window. In here you turn the line into a spot colour. Create a new swatch. Name the swatch Cut, turn it into a spot colour as 100% Magenta. Click OK to apply. The line will not be printed.
